News from GSO New York

Having recently attended the Area 22 Northern Indiana Assembly in Lafayette on February 19, I am able to share with you the following news from the General Service Office in New York:

Beginning April 3, the cost of purchasing books and literature from GSO will increase 20% for books and 30% for pamphlets.

The need to raise prices is a result of the increase in production costs and reduction of profit margins on such books and literature. The most recent price increase was done in 2014 and was 18.75%.

Prior to the Covid pandemic, costs of literature production was 31 - 34 % of sales. Those same costs are now 42 - 56% of sales. That has resulted in the loss of \$1.2 million dollars for the GSO.

GSO relies on two streams of income: literature sales and member/group donations. Group donations are down and individual donations are limited to \$5,000 annually.

Many of you are aware that the new Big Books and the new Twelve Steps & Twelve Traditions are being printed without "jackets." The covers of both books are now being printed directly onto the front covers because New York was unable to obtain paper for the jackets.

It is expected that large buyers will try to 'stock up' on books, so GSO NY is being mindful to make sure supplies are not depleted to allow local and regional CSO offices to still obtain books before the price increase.

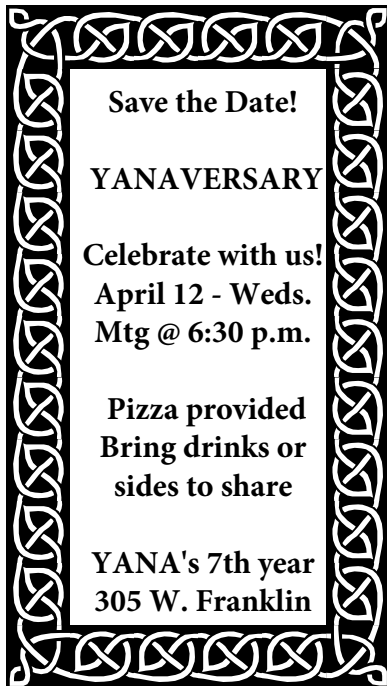
