Lester LeRoy Brown, age 81, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, January 18, 2022 in the comfort of his home. Lester was born on September 19, 1940 in Elkhart to the late Floyd N. Brown and Winfred A. (Troyer) Brown. Lester married Mary I. (Oaks) Brown, together they raised their three daughters. Jae, Tonya and Laura. On January 1, 1989, he married Arleta "Sue" Ogeltree. She died on October 22, 2009. In addition to his parents, Lester is preceded in death by his first wife Mary I. Brown, sister Marlene and a grandson Mark Alter.
